WCMS Awarded \$1K Neighborhood Grant from The Starbucks Foundation

Asheville, NC – The Western Carolina Medical Society is pleased to announce that The Starbucks Foundation has awarded the organization a \$1K Neighborhood Grant to address access to affordable healthcare.

Specifically, this grant will support WCMS's Project Access program, which provides low-income, uninsured patients, ages 18 to 64 living in Buncombe and Madison counties, a barrier-free avenue to comprehensive healthcare ranging from outpatient specialty care to inpatient surgeries, says WCMS CEO Elisa Quarles.

"The Starbucks Foundation Neighborhood Grant ensures that Project Access continues to provide pathways to healthcare for our Western North Carolina neighbors," said Quarles. "This grant will help us to sustain the health of our neighbors and bolster our flourishing communities."

WCMS' Project Access provides free or low-cost comprehensive medical care to low-income, uninsured individuals. This medical care ranges from primary care, specialty care, inpatient surgeries, mental health, and medications to interpreter services, referrals, and navigation for socio-economic resources.

The Starbucks Foundation Neighborhood Grants program offers grants to organizations that one or more Starbucks partners (employees) have nominated based on the important work they are leading in our communities. During Starbucks Global Month of Good in April 2023, The Starbucks Foundation received 19,000 nominations from Starbucks partners and alumni across the U.S. and Canada. 1,900 nonprofits were selected to receive a Neighborhood Grant.
